OUTSIDE COUNSEL ALSO DETERMINED THAT THREE HOURS OF THE DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS' TIME AND TWO HOURS OF THE EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT'S TIME WERE SPENT ON POLITICAL CAMPAIGN ACTIVITIES WHILE AT THE NSBA OFFICE. OUTSIDE COUNSEL ADVISED TO HAVE THE DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REIMBURSE NSBA FOR THE VALUE OF SUCH TIME. CONSEQUENTLY, IN OCTOBER 2015, THE DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FULLY REIMBURSED NSBA FOR THE FULLY-BURDENED COST TO NSBA OF THAT TIME, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$513, PLUS THE RELATED EXCISE TAXES OF \$64, FOR A TOTAL REIMBURSEMENT TO NSBA OF \$577. IN ADDITION, A POLITICAL ACTIVITY POLICY WAS ADDED TO THE STAFF SECTION OF NSBA'S POLICY MANUAL PROHIBITING THE USE OF NSBA RESOURCES IN CONNECTION WITH POLITICAL CAMPAIGN ACTIVITIES IN SUPPORT OF OR IN OPPOSITION TO CANDIDATES. 
