



## PROCEDURES FOR ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION & BYLAWS

<b>Subject:</b>	<b>AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION &amp; BYLAWS</b>
<b>How Adopted?</b>	By a <b>two-thirds vote</b> of the Delegate Assembly.
<b>How Long in Effect?</b>	The Constitution remains in effect unless amended by the procedures outlined herein.
<b>How Does the Committee Operate?</b>	The Constitution & Bylaws Committee consists of five members—one representative from each Region, to be appointed by the President of NSBA from the Board of Directors. It reviews all proposed amendments to the Constitution, reports on its meeting, and makes recommendations to the Delegate Assembly. If the Committee recommends modification of a proposal, it shall notify the sponsoring group of the proposed alteration. If the sponsoring group finds the alterations unacceptable, the original proposal, together with the Committee's recommendations shall be submitted to the Delegate Assembly. The Delegate Assembly shall consider all proposals that meet the requirements for amendments to the Constitution & Bylaws. Written notice of proposed amendments shall be sent to each delegate at least ten days prior to the Delegate Assembly.
