



CONSTITUTIONAL PROCEDURES FOR THE ADOPTION OF NSBA BELIEFS & POLICIES AND RESOLUTIONS

Subject:	BELIEFS & POLICIES
How Adopted?	By a two-thirds vote of the Delegate Assembly.
How Long in Effect?	Beliefs & Policies are permanent and remain in effect until changed.
How Does the Committee Operate?	All Beliefs & Policies are considered first by the Policies & Resolutions Committee. The Policies & Resolutions Committee consists of school board members appointed by the President of NSBA and elected by the Regions. It reviews all proposed Beliefs & Policies; it makes an official report of its meeting at least 30 days before the Beliefs & Policies are to be voted upon; and, it holds an open hearing at the Conference on its recommendations.

Subject:	RESOLUTIONS
How Adopted?	By a simple majority vote of the Delegate Assembly.
How Long in Effect?	Resolutions remain in effect for one year.
How Does the Committee Operate?	All resolutions are considered first by the Policies & Resolutions Committee. The Policies & Resolutions Committee consists of school board members appointed by the President of NSBA and elected by the Regions. It reviews all proposed resolutions; it makes an official report of its meeting at least 30 days before the resolutions are to be voted upon; and, it holds an open hearing at the Conference on its recommendations. It may amend its report as a result of the hearing.
